

Thanks to a grant from the Waldorf Schools Fund, Summerfield Waldorf School and Farm has been able to begin a much anticipated and needed septic upgrade construction project. This septic upgrade is really the gateway for all future growth for the school, as an upgrade of SWSF's aging septic system is necessary for the school to obtain a building permit for any significant remodel or expansion of it's facilities. SWSF anticipates beginning construction of an Art Tech building in winter of 2016 to accommodate the needs of a growing high school. The Art Tech building will house blacksmith, woodwork and ceramics classes, all essential to a Waldorf curriculum. This septic upgrade is thus a critical need for the campus and the school's future growth and sustainability.
